



### My timeline for Christian Hawkes:

- 1812 - Christian Hawkes born
- 1830 - Elizabeth Hawkes (Christians Mother) is the Publican of the Anchor Inn at Higham Wharf
- 1840 - Clerk at Iron Wharf
- 1841 - Christian Hawkes marries Amelia Robinson
- 1842 - **Census** - Higham Wharf - Wharfinger
- 1846 - Son - Edmund born - Christian Hawkes occupation is listed as Publican
- 1850 - Appointed Constable
- 1851 - **Census** - 48b Newland Street, Higham Ferrers - Butcher & Merchant
- 1858 - Resident at Wakefield? (Might be a farm or an area)
- 1861 - **Census** - 66b High Street, Higham Ferrers - Butcher & Merchant
- 1862 - Bankrupt & Goods Sold Off
- 1864 - Receives some money from Ruth (Eady) Robinson's estate - Amelia's mother.
- 1866 - Summoned for none payment of Poor Rate
- 1868 - Fined for none Payment of Poor Rate
- 1871 - **Census** - 24b High Street, Higham Ferrers - Farmer of 8½ acres
- 1871 - Son - Christian Hawkes is married in 1871 and emigrates to USA**
- 1879 - Son John Francis Bankrupt
- 1881 - **Census** - 183b High Street, Higham Ferrers - Farmer of 8 acres
- 1888 - Working as an Attendance Officer
- 1890 - Christian and Amelia Die
