I give and bequeath unto my daughter Margaret Elvidge the magony bedstead in The Top Bed Room it came from Inglewood The mahogany chest of draws & dressing table & glass in the front bed room The Picture of a little girl that was Noras The oil painting of a River seen with cottage & Four Figures the Low small easy childs chair and the French Gilt Clock with Glass shade For Gwen as a wedding present from Grandad when she marries For my Eldest son William my silver watch & my gold and Torquoise scarf pin my Wireless set The oil Painting of an Old Castle with Front gate & 2 Figures The China cubboard in the Front Room For my son Arthur my diamond scarf pin from Harrods The China Cabinet with all the Japanese China in the Front Room cubboard the oil Painting of horse Swallow To my son Fred my Family Bible and any Pictures & Books he would like & my Gold & Moonstone scarf Pin all my securities to be sold & half the money I give to my daughter Margaret Mrs Lous Elvidge and 1 quarter to my eldest son William and the other quarter to my son Arthur & if my wife is still alive at my death my daughter Margaret Mrs Elvidge & my son William & my son Arthur to make her money up to £1. a week as she will have the Old Age Pension of 10/- the other 10/- to be paid by my children Daisy William Arthur & Fred And all my other goods to be divided or sold as they think best All my Funeral Exens to be paid out of my Estate and my 2 Excutors to be paid £3..0 each £6. out of my Estate The old Print of

Grafton Underwood Church for my Brother Albert & a Painting of a little dog Friday by Miss Archer for my Nephew Arthur Hawkes & my best black over coat by made by Brew & Farr for my Brother Arthur all other Books China & Furniture to be sold or divided as my children wish also the Pictures Any Jewlery I leave for my daughter Mrs Louis Elvidge All my securities will be in my small brown Bag.
