

Wellingborough Petty Sessions, June 18 1880

Before H. M. Stockdale, Esq. (chairman), and G. J. H. Pearson

Henry Hasler, Finedon, was summoned for being drunk and riotous, in that village, on the 10th inst and for assaulting his wife, Charlotte Hasler, at Finedon, on the same date.

The defendant brought a long list of charges against his wife. As to the assault, he was bound over, his own recognisances and that of one surety £10, to keep the peace for three months and for being drunk, he was fined 5s. and 10s. 6d costs
