

Night Poaching on Saturday morning 4<sup>th</sup> November 1893

A man named George Hawkes alias "the Reverend" a shoe hand  
Residing at Stanion was brought to the police station in a trap by PC  
Holt of Brigstock and some keepers

Later that day the prisoner was taken before Mr Roughton and  
Charged with night poaching at Stanion Woods and formal evidence  
Having been given By Mr W Marlow a gamekeeper defendant was remanded  
Until Wednesday next.

There had been a desperate struggle between the accused and his captors and the  
Prisoner bearing marks of several blows
